

Notes to Renminbi Remittance to the Mainland of China

To follow the requirements of the People's Bank of China, we refer to the third bullet point under section 6.1 of our "Supplemental Information On Renminbi Services" informing you that, the payer is required to provide us the Name, Address and SWIFT BIC of the beneficiary bank for Renminbi remittance to the Mainland of China.

Please note that, as from 1 June 2021, without providing the above required information, the remittance will be charged additional fee and may be delayed or rejected. The additional fee will be charged according to the "Amendment/Cancellation/Returned" (Plus Correspondent Bank Charges) of our "NCB Remittance Tariff" and may be deducted from remittance proceeds or claimed against the payer.
